Parks and Playgrounds in Alexandria

22314

Armory Tot Lot is geared toward children ages 2-5 and includes a large sandbox, double teeter totter, tunnel slide, double slide, two climbing features, and two bucket swings, located at 208 S. Royal Street.

Jones Point Park is a newly-renovated park featuring an Adventure Ship structure, climbing equipment, slides, a seesaw, a separate toddler area, and two basketball courts. Jones Point was a shipyard used during World War I. You can see the ship's rudder here along with panels along trails highlighting the history and importance of the shipyard during colonial times, located at **125 Jones Point Drive.**

Montgomery Playground contains a fenced

dog area, four lighted tennis courts, shaded picnic gazebo, a water fountain, and a playground with slides and climbing equipment, located at 901 N. Royal Street.

Powhatan Park contains a small mulch playground featuring slides, a bouncy horse, climbing bars, a teeter totter, and swing, located at 1010 Douglas Street.

South Royal Street Park is tucked away located at **200 South Royal Street** and features a small playground and sandbox.

Windmill Hill Park (also known as Lee Street Park) contains a large playground featuring slides, tunnels, monkey bars, a suspension bridge, rope walls, swings, a seesaw, a sand-box, a sand volleyball court, basketball

courts, and a large field, located at 501 South Union Street. The park can also be accessed from the **500 S. block of Lee Street**.

E. Del Ray Ave. Park Playground is a small woodland-themed playground featuring climbing equipment, a slide, and bench seating located at 1 and **7 E. Del Ray Avenue**.

22302

Chinquapin Park is a smaller playground located at **3210 King Street** next to TC Williams High School and includes slides, a chain link cargo net, pull up bars, tunnels, steering mechanisms, a tic tac toe board, and swings. Also located at Chinquapin is an indoor public pool and rec center.

22304

Armistead L. Boothe Park includes several different play areas which contain slides, climbing structures, swings, and a basketball court, located at **520 Cameron Station Boulevard.**

Ben Brenman Park is an enclosed playground with a soft, rubber surface and features slides, swings, rubber stepping stones, and a mini rock climbing wall, located at **4800 Brenman**Park Drive.

Fort Ward Park is a tucked away park with a playground including a rock wall, a chain ladder, a suspension bridge, stepping stones, corkscrew bars, slides and swings. The park, which also contains numerous picnic areas, an amphitheater and dog exercise area, and houses a Civil War museum, is located at **4301 West Braddock Road.**

Holmes Run Park is a mulch playground containing swings, monkey bars, climbing equipment, and benches located at **4800 Brenman Park Drive.**

Stevenson Square Park is a quaint community park featuring a basketball court, picnic area, baseball field, and small playground, located at **300 Stultz Road**.

Beverly Park, affectionately known to locals as "The Pit," sits on a mulch surface and contains a cargo net, monkey bars, climbers, a zip line slider, four slides, ladders, a corkscrew climber, a mini rock climbing wall, a cargo chain and suspension bridge. The Pit, which also features an attached playhouse and a small fire truck, a double see saw, swings, and a large sandbox, is located at **620 N. Overlook Drive.**

Hume Springs Park is a small mulch playground with climbing equipment, bucket swings, monkey bars, and a slide, located at 100 Dale Street.

Lynhaven Park contains two metal cargo chain nets, tic tac toe boards, a tunnel, steering wheels, swings, and a spring rider that seats four, located at **5 E. Reed Avenue.**

Potomac Yard Park Playground & Sprayground contains two separate fenced playgrounds both consisting of rubber surfaces. The toddler playground features small slides, a teeter-totter,

swings, a mirror-filled maze, steering wheels, crawling spaces, and tic-tac-toe boards. The older playground includes swings, stepping stumps, metal rings, a cargo chain and dual rock wall, a zip line, teeter-totters, jungle gyms, balance beams and spring beams, slides, and hammocks. In between the two playgrounds is an interactive fountain, along with tennis, basketball and volleyball courts, all located at **2501 Potomac Avenue**.

Groveton Heights Park is a small neighborhood playground featuring slides, trapeze rings, a fireman's pole, and benches, located at **3429 Clayborne Avenue**.


Lenclair Park features swings, slides, tunnels, and monkey bars on both a grass and mulch surface, located at 6625 Lenclair Street. Martin Luther King Jr. Park is a large community park featuring slides, a telescope window,

monkey bars, metal rings, steering wheels, a Martin Luther King Jr. Park is a large community park featuring slides, a telescope window, monkey bars, metal rings, steering wheels, a tic tac toe board, a rock wall, ladders, swings, and trapeze rings located at 8115 Fordson Road. Stoneybrooke Park is a small mulch playground featuring swings, slides, tunnels, climbing equipment, and benches, located at 3900 Stoneybrooke Drive.

Collingwood Park is a massive park offering tennis courts, open space, soccer and baseball fields, and a large playground featuring slides, swings, and climbing equipment, located at **8200 West Boulevard Drive.**

Stratford Landing Park is a large neighborhood playground with swings, slides, climbing equipment, tic-tac-toe-boards, animal rockers, a large field, basketball courts, and tennis courts, located at **2301 Stirrup Lane.**



George Washington Grist Mill Park contains athletic fields for soccer, softball, baseball and football, two full-size basketball courts, a large playground with climbing equipment, and the perimeter of the park has hiking and biking trails that bypass a dog park. Once the site of a former farm lane, it also contained an overseer's house and slave dwellings, located at 5512 Mount Vernon Memorial Highway.

Mt. Vernon Manor Park is tucked away behind a cul-de-sac and features a baseball field, tennis courts, trails, a picnic area shaded by trees, a playground that has swings, a frog spring rocker, slides, ladders, rings and a spiral climbing gym, located at **8600 McNair Drive.**

Mt. Vernon Woods Park contains a small mulch playground with swings, slides, and climbing equipment, located at **4014 Fielding**Street

Muddy Hole Farm Park includes tennis courts, a soccer field, three basketball courts, picnic tables with a grill, and a playground with tunnels, slides, and climbing equipment, located at **7941 Kidd Street**.

Woodley Hills Park is a neighborhood park featuring tennis courts and a playground with slides, swings, tic-tac-toe, a steering wheel, ladders, rings, and climbing equipment, located at **8710 Old Mt. Vernon Road.**

Chessie's Big Backyard is located at **6601 Telegraph Road** inside Lee District Park and features a climbing web, climbing ropes,

rocks, tree stumps, stone walls, a rope ladder, suspension bridges, various ramps. Interactive gadgets throughout the playground allow kids to track the sounds of a skunk, raccoon, river otter and alligator and search for woodland animals along the rubber surface.

Bren Mar Park features several slides, a suspension bridge, climbing blocks, a pull up bar, a steering wheel, a picnic area, and a baseball field, located at **6324 Edsall Road.**

22315

Hayfield Park is a mulch playground containing stepping stumps, whisper phones, animal and baseball tic-tac-toes, mini climbing wall, a rock mountain, slides, and a crawling tunnel. The playground is accompanied by a circular stone area with stone benches and a large grass field, located at **7611 Hayfield Road**.





Alexandria Kid Friendly Restaurants

Holy Cow

2312 Mount Vernon Avenue

Looking for delicious hand cut fries, burgers, and shakes? Try out Holy Cow in Del Ray. The relaxed counter service environment is perfect for families and the restaurant is stroller-friendly. The outdoor seating is perfect for when the weather warms up. Holy Cow's kids menu is great for picky eaters.

Faccia Luna

823 S. Washington Street

Faccia Luna was named Best Pizza by Washington City Paper (2015 and 2016) and it deserves the title! Try the Via Toscana, a white pizza with caramelized onions, prosciutto, and smoked gouda or its signature Faccia Luna, with sausage, mushroom, and roasted red peppers. Faccia Luna offers a variety of Italian menu options, including pasta and sandwiches,

Lena's Wood-Fired Pizza and Tap

401 E. Braddock Road

Lena's, an Italian eatery on the edge of Rosemont, has wood-fired pizza and Italian food. Try the diavola pizza with salami, mozzarella, fried kale, and ghost pepper honey (don't worry it's not too spicy) or stick to the classic margherita.

Northside 10

10 E. Glebe Road

Northside 10 has great options for the whole family. You can find a variety of burgers, sandwiches, and salads. Be sure to start with one of the killer appetizers, like the fried Brussel sprouts with bacon and asiago, or the risotto fritters fixed with Gruyere cheese, parmesan, tomato and bacon gravy.

Zento

693 N. Washington Street

Zento has a great sushi and a family-friendly relaxed atmosphere. It is counted in the top Asian restaurants in Alexandria. Choose from one of the sushi assortments served with miso soup and a house salad or try one of their other delicious Asian dishes.

Momo Sushi

212 Queen Street

Momo Sushi's lunch special can't be beat. It's \$10.95 lunchtime bento box includes Chicken Teriyaki, a six-piece California Roll, plus salad, rice, and miso soup. For dinner, you can also choose from one of Momo's 10 sushi combos, rice bowls, or yakisoba noodle dishes.

Vola's

101 N Union Street

Offering one of the best waterfront dining views in Old Town, Vola's is a fabulous spot

for a seafood lunch. Try the Chesapeake Bay Chowder, made with blue crab, to start. For your main dish, try a lobster roll, blackened grouper sandwich, or firecracker shrimp tacos — with a side of Old Bay Fries, of course. Its "Red Hot Apple Cobbler" is the perfect way to end your meal, with its special ingredient of spicy red hot candies and cooling cinnamon ice cream. Located in the Torpedo Factory, Vola's offers both indoor and outdoor seating as well as the Hi-Tide lounge, a throwback cocktail lounge.

Chadwick's

203 Strand Street

Their slogan "casual dining at its very best" truly lives up to its claim. The perfect quick place to dine in the Southeast Quadrant of Old Town, Chadwick's has a kid-friendly brunch and amazing clam chowder. Visit on a Monday for half-priced burgers all day.



The Majestic

911 King Street

The Majestic owned by the Alexandria Restaurant Partners offers seasonal menus for lunch, dinner, and brunch. The new American restaurant offers an upscale-casual atmosphere. Executive chef Graham Duncan, who served as the opening executive chef for Founding Farmers in D.C., ensures all produce, dairy, and meat are sourced from local farmers in Virginia and Maryland.

Los Tios Grill

2615 Mount Vernon Avenue

This local favorite Tex-Mex grill sits just on the edge of the Avenue, in Del Ray. With huge portion sizes and unbeatable, authentic tastes, Los Tios Grill is Del Ray's go-to spot for school fundraisers, birthday parties, and any other excuse to enjoy the environment inside and out. Los Tios has the best chips and salsa in town, hands down; combined with incredible service and an affordable selection, it is hard to beat this top Del Ray restaurant!

el Poblano is yet another reason to stop by!

Pork Barrel BBQ

2312 Mount Vernon Avenue When Pork Barrel BBQ opened in 2011, it quickly became Del Ray's hottest restaurant. In what is already considered the Avenue's most visited block, Pork Barrel joined Del Ray's famous St. Elmo's Coffee Pub and The Dairy Godmother. Pork Barrel brings nationally ranked BBQ to the heart of Del Ray, attracting BBQ lovers from all over the region to this family-friendly restaurant. It also features arcade games, a sports bar, and outdoor seating. Next door neighbors, Holy Cow and the Sushi Bar, are owned by the same local restaurant group which allows for a connected flow of food and energy across all three dining spaces. After indulging in an award-winning sandwich, the "Del Ray" thing to do is stroll down the block for frozen custard or pastry at the Dairy Godmother.



Namaste

Take your kids to try Indian food at Namaste in Old Town. The spacious restaurant is family-friendly and has an extensive menu. New to Indian food? The friendly staff always offers great recommendations. The Palak Ki Chat is a delicious appetizer as well as one of their many types of Naan.

Caphe Banh Mi

407 Cameron Street

For Wisconsin-style frozen custard, take a trip to Del Ray to visit The Dairy Godmother (highly recommended by Allison!). What makes frozen custard different from ice cream? Well, it has at least 1.4% pasteurized egg yolk, at least 10% milk fat, and is made in a certain machine using a very specific technique. The result is an amazingly creamy and smooth summer treat. Vanilla and Chocolate

custard are available daily, plus a Flavor of the Day. The Dairy Godmother also offers an incredible variety of sorbets (dairy-free!) in enticing flavors like, Lemon Lavender, Strawberry Balsamico, Orange Blossom, Pineapple with Cilantro, Cucumber with Fresh Mint, Pear with Vanilla, and many more.

Pop's

109 King Street

With its old-fashioned atmosphere and fabulous customer service, Pop's Old Fashioned Ice Cream is a local favorite. You can find the usual standby flavors at Pop's, but also some truly unique ones like Kahlua Chocolate Chip, Peanut Butter Chocolate Pretzel, and Carrot Cake. Or try one of their specialty sundaes such as the "Johnny Appleseed," with vanilla ice cream, apple pie chunks, butterscotch, caramel, and whipped cream. A lactose-free soft serve ice cream is also available at Pop's.






